Eyck Freymann is a Hoover Fellow at Stanford University and one of America's leading experts on U.S.-China strategic competition. He is the author of multiple acclaimed books, including *The Arsenal of Democracy: Technology, Industry, and Deterrence in an Age of Hard Choices* and *One Belt One Road: Chinese Power Meets the World* (Harvard University Press), hailed as the "definitive" study of China's global strategy. His latest work, [*Defending Taiwan: A Strategy to Prevent War with China*](#) published in April 2026.

Dr. Freymann serves as a Non-Resident Research Fellow at the U.S. Naval War College and advises senior policymakers in the United States and allied countries across the full spectrum of U.S.-China competition—from economic warfare and technology competition to infrastructure diplomacy and military deterrence. His commentary appears regularly in *The Wall Street Journal*, *The New York Times*, *Foreign Affairs*, *The Economist*, and *War on the Rocks*, focusing on national security issues of bipartisan concern.
