Before her name became interlocked with images of celebrity, wealth and power, Leibovitz was at the cutting edge of counterculture in the late 60s. At just 19 years old, Leibovitz took a photograph of Allen Ginsberg smoking at an anti-Vietnam march. A friend urged her to submit it to Rolling Stone which then became the cover of the June 1970 issue. By the age of 24, she was Rolling Stone's chief photographer.

As a gifted visual storyteller, she has captured the spirit of the people and events that have shaped history – and the media – over the past four decades. From Rolling Stone to The Rolling Stones, the Queen of England to John Lennon, Bill Gates to Mark Zuckerberg; Leibovitz's legendary career continues to place her at the center of the world's most fascinating people. Most recently, Leibovitz is the newest instructor for the very popular online classroom MASTERCLASS, where she teaches aspiring photographers everything from developing concepts to lighting and photography equipment to post-production techniques.

However, Annie's heart goes far beyond the objects of her photographs and classrooms. Her passion falls within protecting humanity, advocating for women, and showcasing the inner beauty that many seem to overlook in today's society. Annie strives to treat each person she encounters not as a celebrity but as someone who is just "great at what they do." She has created work that ignites conversation of passion, admiration, and outrage and gives the world a glimpse of her personal lenses – personal life experiences, hardships and war, and an abundance of lessons learned.
